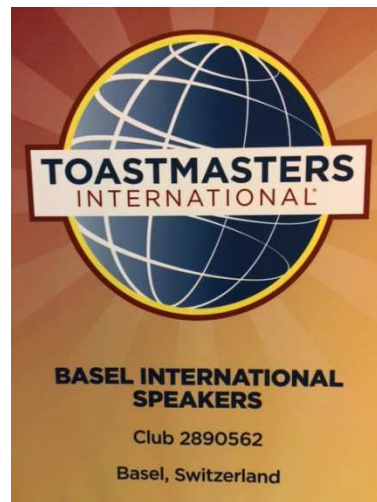
The event lasts from 09:00 to about 12:30 and will be held at the University of Basel. There will be two contests in two languages (English and German).
